The source comprises eight partbooks. The present motet is no. 2 in the publication.

**Editorial method:** Original part names, time signatures and note durations have been retained. Clefs have been modernised, with originals appearing in prefatory staves. The overall range of each part is given in black stemless notes before the initial time signature, to which the music has been barred. The pitch has been lowered *alla quinta bassa* in deference to the *chiavi alti*. Editorial accidentals appear above the staff.


