Preface

After having written a number of mass settings for only three parts or even two parts, I thought it was time to eventually set a mass ordinary for the most common four part tessitura. Due to its succinct style and the convenient voice ranges, I hope that this setting will be quite useful for liturgical use.

The piece utilizes the Phrygian mode, which is characterized by a leading tone from above, which sets it apart from modern major and minor tonality. The Gloria cites Gloria XV from the Kyriale Romanum. Note that the last bar in the top voice of the Kyrie is not an error, although the note values do not add up to the values of the other parts: This is meant to indicate that eventually all parts come to rest on a long note of unspecified length.
